Officers answer calls, take reports, investigate vehicle crashes, perform traffic enforcement, conduct their own case investigations.

A strong working knowledge of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure is a must, as you will often be working without direct supervision.

Investigative experience is preferred.

Experience in preparing arrest and search warrant affidavits is preferred.
