Requirements:

It is preferred but not required for officers to reside within the city limits of Tahoka. The requirements of this position are:

- Must have a current Texas Peace officer License issued by TCOLE.
- Must be over the age of 21 years old
- Must not be convicted of a Class B Misdemeanor in the last ten years
- Must not have any felony convictions
- Must be able to lawfully own or possess a firearm
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must possess a High School Diploma or General Equivalency Diploma
- Must be able to pass a drug screen and background check
- Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License
- All applicants must be able to pass a physical (medical) and psychological examination
- Must be able to work a flexible shift, including nights, weekends, and holidays
- Must be able to work in inclement weather
