

The Brewster County Sheriff's Office currently has an opening for a full time deputy sheriff and is seeking qualified applicants. The deputy sheriff will be working for the Brewster County Sheriff and established chain of command, the deputy sheriff will be responsible for the enforcement of the laws of the State of Texas and Brewster County, and to protect the lives and property of the citizens. The deputy will respond to citizens' calls for assistance, seek to observe and apprehend criminal offenders, investigate major/minor criminal and non-criminal incidents, traffic violators, and prevent criminal activity and civil disorders, and performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications include: Must be licensed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) and maintain current TCOLE license. Must possess a valid Texas Drivers License. Must be at least 21 years of age and have a high school diploma. Applicants must also be mentally and physically fit to discharge the duties of a deputy sheriff. Position pays just under \$40,000 annually and overtime is available through border related grants. The person hired for this position **may** have the opportunity for free housing in a privately owned resort community located in the area.
