



Civil Service Police Applicant Test

January 28, 2017

Written testing will be held at the Johnnie Arolfo Civic Center, 400 W Walker St, League City, TX 77573. Registration must be completed online by visiting www.lcpdcareers.com. Testing will begin promptly at 8:00am. Candidates must bring their testing confirmation ticket and identification to be allowed in the testing site.

The civil service exam is a Nelson Denny Reading Comprehension and Vocabulary timed Test. The written process will take approximately one hour. You will be provided time to change for the physical assessment test when you pass the written.

Upon successful completion of the civil service exam, you will immediately transition to the physical assessment portion of the evaluation. The physical fitness test will consist of the following:


- 34 Sit-ups in 1 Minute
- 30 Push-ups in 1 Minute
- 300 Meter Sprint in 65 Seconds
- 1.5 Mile Run in 15 Minutes

The selection process is thorough and may take between 90 and 180 days. All applicants must successfully pass each of the following phases in order to be considered for employment.

- Applicants meet all City of League City eligibility requirements
- Applicants pass the written exam
- Applicants pass the physical capacity test
- Complete and turn in the Personal History Packet
- Applicants must pass an oral board interview
- Pass a compressive background investigation
- Pass polygraph examination
- Pass a medical examination and drug test
- Pass psychological test and evaluation
