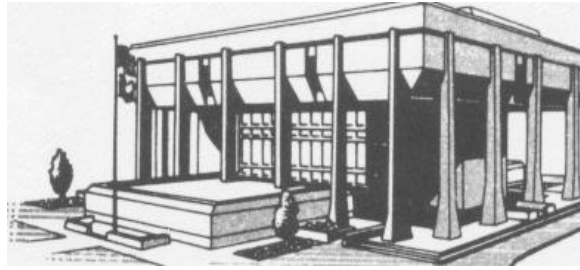

## Courthouse Security

Taylor County is currently seeking qualified applicants for **Deputy Sheriff in Courthouse Security Division at the Taylor County Courthouse**. All applicants must have a high school diploma or GED and hold a current peace officer's license in Texas. Applicants must have the ability to make clear, split-second decisions during high stress situations. Must be able to work additional hours when required.

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, in good physical condition, and must pass a physical exam and drug screening prior to employment. Qualified applicants will also be subject to extensive criminal history and background investigation.
