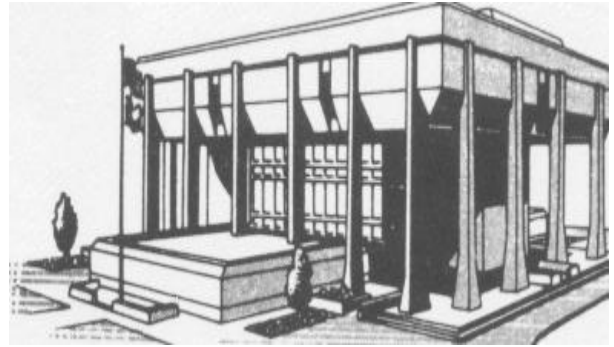

## Patrol Deputy

Taylor County is currently seeking qualified applicants for a **Patrol Deputy** in the **Sheriff's Office**.

All applicants must have a high school diploma or GED, hold a current Texas peace officer's license, and have a valid Driver's License. Applicants must have the ability to make clear, split-second decisions during high-stress situations. Must be able to work additional hours when required.

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, in good physical condition, and must pass a physical exam and drug screening prior to employment. Qualified applicants will also be subject to extensive criminal history and background investigation.
