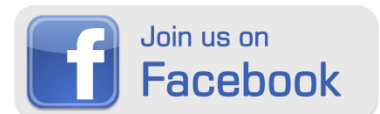

BENEFITS

MEDICAL AND LIFE INSURANCE:

The Town of Hollywood Park offers comprehensive health and medical insurance, along with life insurance and coverage for accidental death and dismemberment, to its regular full-time staff. The city covers the premiums for its employees.

RETIREMENT:

The City is a member of the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS). The City will contribute to the employees retirement account at a rate of 2:1. Employees are vested in the TMRS system after 5 years of service.

TRAINING:

State mandated training is provided at no cost to the employees as well as numerous other opportunities to advance education.

EQUIPMENT:

The city furnishes all essential equipment, such as body armor, duty weapon(s), tasers, duty belts, and gear to its officers. Additionally, officers are eligible for an annual clothing allowance of \$600.00 after completing one year of service in each fiscal year.



REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a break of more than 180 days in service will also be required to submit to a psychological assessment.

Please see the below requirements before you submit your application.

Minimum qualifications that apply to all applicants for the position of Police Officer must meet the following:

- Age of 21
- Graduate of a State approved academy
- Currently licensed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.
- High School graduate or GED
- Pass a written examination
- Pass physical agility test
- Pass an oral interview
- Pass a in-depth background investigation
- Pass a physical examination, psychological screening, and drug test.
- Does not have any tattoos that violate HPPD SOP 134.
