

Town of Thompsons Police Officer Summary of duties:

This position serves the needs of the community by enforcing federal, state, and local laws and ordinances. In addition, this position performs patrol functions, makes investigations and arrests suspects, provides assistance to citizens, controls traffic, and responds to other emergencies. Thompsons is a small rural town, you will report to the Mayor. Primarily this is a community protection position – get to know the residents of our town, understand the traffic challenges with school routes, and Power Plant shift changes. We are on the main line for the BNSF railroad and often have to deal with traffic closures because of train -truck collisions. We would also like a candidate willing to work with the Volunteer Fire Department while on duty. When severe weather strikes, the ideal candidate will know which residents need to be alerted and evacuated. Town of Thompsons provides health care, and equipment needed for this position.

Thompsons is a small town on the west side of the Brazos River in Fort Bend County. We have the support of the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Department and mutual aid agreements in place.

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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Must meet all requirements as established by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education (TCOLE) Basic Certification.
- Must have graduated from a certified Police Academy and passed the TCOLE Basic Peace Officer Licensing Exam or successfully completed these requirements.
- Must hold a valid Texas peace officer license and have never had a license issued by any State law enforcement regulatory commission revoked.
- Must possess a current, valid Texas driver's license.
