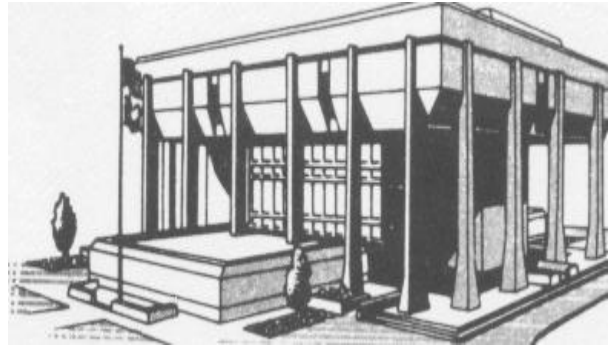

Transport Deputy

Taylor County is currently seeking qualified applicants for **Transport Deputy at the Sheriff's Office**. All applicants must have a high school diploma or GED and hold a current Texas peace officer's license.

Primary duties and responsibilities for this position include but are not limited to: Transporting of inmates to and from the Courts and medical appointments, Subpoena service, Courthouse security duties, Warrant service, and all other department duties deemed necessary by the Sheriff or Division Commanders.

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, in good physical condition, and must pass a physical exam and drug screening prior to employment. Qualified applicants will also be subject to extensive criminal history and background investigation.

All applicants must complete a Taylor County Sheriff's Office Personal History Statement to turn in with the application. This form is available online or in the Human Resources office.
