- successfully complete the Jail Firearms Course (course number 3599), or have successfully completed a Basic Peace Officer Course, AND,
- have a firearms qualification for the type of weapon to be carried (Rule 218.9) within the last 12 months. **The current firearms qualification must accompany this application.**

After award of the certificate the applicant is subject to the continuing firearms qualification requirements of Rule 218.9.

The certificate becomes invalid if the applicant is not currently firearms qualified.
